We will then invite these young men to the AGR house in Murray on Saturday, May 2, 2009 to tour the campus and the city of Murray. After the tour we will then have an open-

house where the young men and their parents can explore our home and we can answer any question they may have. We will then provide lunch and begin the interview process of each candidate. After the interview process is complete, the members and alumni will choose the winners and contact them by phone within a week of the interviews.

- Must be an incoming male freshman to Murray State University
- Must be majoring in Agriculture
- Scholastic Record: 3.0 GPA
